This event is sanctioned by the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc., herein after referred to as USDAA®. The rules and regulations of the USDAA® shall apply at this event and are hereby incorporated by reference.

#### **ENTRIES AND CLOSING DATES**

Entries must be received by Wednesday, July 7<sup>th</sup>. Entries will be accepted by special delivery services ONLY IF THE SIGNATURE WAIVER is signed. No telephone entries will be accepted. Entries received after the closing date will be returned. There is no limit to the number of dogs that can participate in this agility trial. Competitors may enter both Championship and Performance Program classes for which they are eligible; however, under NO circumstances may a dog be entered in the same Championship and Performance class at this agility test (i.e. standard at any level in both programs).

You may request a change in or cancel your entry in writing, via U.S. postal service or email [spottedwoz@comcast.net](mailto:spottedwoz@comcast.net) at any time prior to the closing date. Secondary closing deadline (Monday July 12<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 pm) is for ADVANCEMENT IN LEVEL ONLY. No refundable cancellations or changes in classes will be permitted after the closing date.

#### **CHECK-IN AND MEASURING**

All competitors must check in their first day of competition. All dogs must be measured prior to being checked in unless the handler sent a copy of the permanent card with entry, the dog jumps 26" (P22"), the handler presents a permanent card, temporary card with 3 signatures awaiting a CMJ or check-in letter issued by USDAA/print out of dog info page from subscriber account indicating the dog is permanently carded. You may attach a copy of your yellow permanent USDAA height card to your entry to expedite check-in. Those who cannot present their permanent card, completed temporary card or USDAA check-in letter will be required to measure in. **Please do not mail actual cards or copies of blue cards.** There will be a self-serve check-in list for those having a permanent card and have sent a copy of it with the entry form.

**Check-in and measuring times will be between 8:00 and 8:30 am both days.  
(12:30 -1:00 pm on Sat. for GP & Steeplechase only)  
Judge's briefing for the first class will be at 8:45, with first dog on the line at 9:00 am sharp.**

**Confirmation of entry and final confirmation with last minute details of the trial will be by EMAIL ONLY. If email is not available to a competitor, please send a self-addressed stamped envelope and the final details will be sent after the secondary closing deadline Monday March 1st.**

#### **PRIZES AND AWARDS**

Ribbons will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> thru 4<sup>th</sup> place in all test classes in each respective jump height. Pairs Relay will be awarded by Mini and Open divisions, 1<sup>st</sup> thru 4<sup>th</sup>. Maroon Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for qualifying scores in ALL titling classes. Ribbons will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> thru 3<sup>rd</sup> place in Grand Prix and Performance Grand Prix. Special qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all Grand Prix and PGP qualifiers. See Steeplechase & Speed Jumping descriptions for awards.

## NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

- Competitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of USDAA® Rules and Regulations, as amended July 1, 2009, including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry, and will comply. USDAA's official Rules and Regulations are hereby incorporated by reference.
- This test is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression.
- To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or guardian for minors), received by the closing date, and accompanied by the correct fees.
- All dogs must be registered with the USDAA® (registration has "U" prefix). A registration form is enclosed with this Agility Test Schedule. This form must be completed and submitted with all entries that do not bear a valid USDAA® registration number.

- All Competitors, through entry at this event, waive any and all rights relative to video broadcast of this event. Competitors shall have the right to videotape portions of this event for their personal use only. No portion of this event may be videotaped for commercial or other purposes. All video, broadcast and telecast rights for this event are the exclusive property of the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc.
- Portions of this event may be taped for television. Through entry at this event, ALL COMPETITORS AND HANDLERS HEREBY GRANT to USDAA® and its representatives, agents and assigns, all rights and permission to use or appropriate his/her and their dogs name, biography, likeness, photograph, voice, performing persona, or other indicia of identity for broadcast, telecast, cablecast, transmission or distribution in any format or media now known or hereafter to become known. All Competitors and handlers hereby release USDAA® and its representatives, agents and assigns from any claim or cause of action for invasion of the rights of privacy, right of publicity, right of personality, or any similar right.
- No leads or collars (except as allowed in the USDAA® Rules), food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time.
- Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.
- The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the committee views that participation by competitor or dog would be prejudicial to the sport. However, any committee so doing must notify the competitor in writing (with a copy to the USDAA® office) in anticipation of or upon receipt of entry. The notice must include the reason for refusing the entry and a brief explanation of the basis for their decision. The burden of responsibility for appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.
- Agility obstacles shall meet the requirements of USDAA® Rules and Regulations.
- Fault limits may be imposed at the discretion of the organizing committee and/or judge.

### ADDITIONALLY:

- A withdrawal after the closing date due to injury or illness of the entered dog, or for bitches who come into season after the closing date will be eligible for a refund minus USDAA® fees plus a service fee of \$5 if supported by a written notice from a veterinarian. In such instances the secretary MUST be notified no later than Friday, July 3rd, with supporting documentation received by Wednesday July 8th. Any other withdrawals after the closing date will not be eligible for refund.
- THERE SHALL BE NO REFUNDS in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for dismissal, or in the event that the test cannot be opened or completed for reasons beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- There will be no refund for overpayment of fees in the amount of \$10 or less/dog.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$20.00 service charge on all returned checks and repeat episodes may require future payment to be a M.O. or Cashier's Check. Payment of entry fees and services shall be made within 30 days of postmark of notice of returned check. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice will result in cancellation of event results for all classes for the registration numbers(s) of delinquent entry/entries. No reinstatement of results is possible. All awards must be returned within 10 days of notification, or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is cancelled without recourse by owner/handler.
- There will **not** be a food vendor available on site. Lunch and bottled water will be available on-site for WORKERS ONLY. However, there are some restaurants nearby in the Dexter & Ann Arbor areas.
- Dogs must be properly kenneled (in crate or pen) or attended (held on leash) at all times except at the warm-up jump or in the ring.
- There will be no electrical hook up for competitors.
- There will be NO equipment familiarization at this event.
- Exhibition Runs (FEO) are permitted only for dogs that "measure up" into a higher height class than that which they entered; however, no qualifying scores or awards may be earned and no change in program is permitted at check-in.

## CLASS DESCRIPTIONS and INFORMATION

GENERAL: Two certification programs will be offered at this event – Championship and Performance. Competitors may enter both Championship and Performance Program classes for which they are eligible. Classes include standard agility, gamblers, jumpers, snooker, and pairs relay as set forth in chapters 3-7 of USDAA Rules and Regulations, each of which are conducted at three competitive levels. Under NO circumstance may a dog be entered in the same Championship and Performance class on the same day at this event. (Example: standard at any level in both Championship and Performance)

**NON-STANDARD CLASSES – GAMBLERS, JUMPERS, SNOOKER, and PAIRS RELAY:** These non-standard classes are scored and judged pursuant to the provisions of Chapters 6 & n7 of USDAA Rules and Regulations. Please see the USDAA Rules for details on the web @ [http://www.usdaa.com/rules\\_eBook.cfm](http://www.usdaa.com/rules_eBook.cfm). Pairs Relay; in the event only one dog is entered in a program/level, un-entered dogs or dogs from another program/level may NOT be recruited to form a qualifying pair. **Effective 1-1-09, Pairs Relay is required for all levels in Performance.**

## 2010 TOURNAMENT CLASSES

**GRAND PRIX OF DOG AGILITY® WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS LOCAL QUALIFIER** This class is open to all competitors other than those entered in the *Performance National Standard* qualifier at this event, regardless of titles earned or skill level. The Grand Prix is a single-round tournament featuring the sport in its basic form. The course includes obstacles as set forth in Chapter 3 of the USDAA Rules and Regulations for standard agility, except that no table obstacle shall be used. Standard scoring shall be applied utilizing time standards generally ranging from 3.5 yards per second (yps) to 3.75 yps for dogs in the 22" and 26" height classes, from 3.10 to 3.40 yps for dogs in the 16" height class and 2.85 to 3.05 yps in the 12" height class.

**AWARDS:** Competitors that earn **ZERO** faults shall earn a qualifying score. In addition, the first place qualifying handler/dog team in each height class shall earn a "bye" voucher, permitting them to directly advance to the final round of a regional championship. 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> place ribbons will be awarded in each jump height. A double maroon and white ribbon shall be awarded to all qualifiers.

**PERFORMANCE GRAND PRIX<sup>SM</sup> CHAMPIONSHIPS LOCAL QUALIFIER** This class is open to all competitors other than those who are entered in the *Grand Prix* qualifier at this event, regardless of titles earned or skill level. This qualifier is a single-round tournament featuring the Performance Program in its basic form. The course includes obstacles as set forth in chapter 7 of the USDAA Rules and Regulations for standard performance class, except that no table obstacle shall be used. Standard scoring shall be applied utilizing time standards generally ranging from 3.30 yards per second (yps) to 3.55 yps for dogs in the 16" and 22" height classes, from 2.95 to 3.25 yps for dogs in the 12" height class and 2.75 to 2.95 yps in the 8" height class.

**AWARDS:** Competitors that earn **ZERO** faults shall earn a qualifying score. In addition, the first place qualifying handler/dog team in each height class shall earn a "bye" voucher, permitting them to directly advance to the final round of a regional championship. 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> place ribbons will be awarded in each jump height. A double maroon and pink ribbon shall be awarded to all qualifiers.

**DOG AGILITY STEEPLECHASE® LOCAL QUALIFIER:** This tournament class is open to any dog regardless of level of competition or titles earned. This is a two-round tournament with emphasis on speed. Each round will be conducted on a jumpers style course that shall include a long jump, A-frame, and weave poles. Either the A-frame or weave poles shall be required to be performed twice. Qualifying scores are earned in round one, prize money and Top Ten Points earned in round two. One qualifying score is required for entry in a Regional event, and two qualifying scores required for entry into the semifinals at the Championships held in the fall. **SCORING:** The tournament shall be conducted pursuant to USDAA Championship Starters level rules, except that scoring in each round shall be on a time plus faults basis, with a five-fault penalty added to a dog's time for each occurrence of a fallen hurdle or missed contact; running the wrong course shall be scored as an elimination as defined under Masters rules

Either the A-frame or weave poles shall be required to be performed twice. Qualifying scores are earned in round one, prize money and Top Ten Points earned in round two. 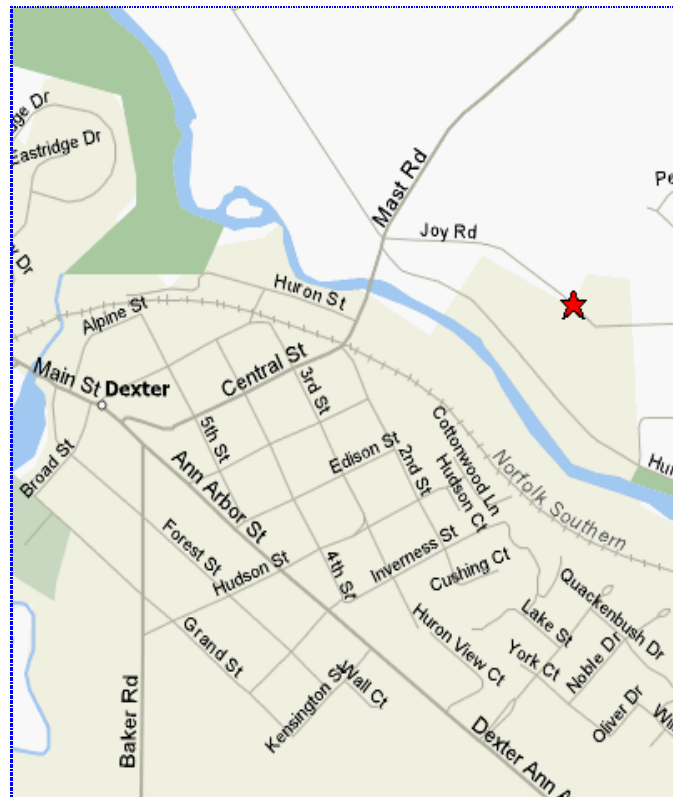

### Directions to the trial site:

**From I-94 (heading west):** Take Zeeb Road exit and head north.

Cross the Huron River and then railroad tracks. At the stop sign turn left onto Huron River Dr.. Pass Dexter-Huron Metro Park on your left. Approximately 1.5 miles down make a right turn onto the cross drive connecting CSRC to Joy Road. The building at the corner is the Dexter Research Center (7300 Huron River Dr.).

**From I-94 (heading east):** Take Baker Road exit and head north.

Stay on Baker Rd. until it ends in downtown Dexter (see map above). Turn left onto Ann Arbor St. and take the immediate right onto Central St. You have to go around 'Monument Park'. Stay on Central and cross the Huron River. There is a party store on the corner where Huron River Dr. and Mast Rd. intersect. Turn right onto Joy Rd. and go approximately 1/4 mile. Turn right and CSRC is the building immediately on your right. Parking is available in the back and side of the building.

**From US-23 (Heading south):** Take North Territorial Rd. exit and head west.

Go approximately 5.5 miles west until you come to a 4-way stop. Turn left onto Mast Rd. and go 3 miles to Joy Rd. (speed limit will drop to 25 here). The Dexter party store is on the left. Turn before the party store, onto Joy Rd., and go approximately 1/4 mile. Turn right onto that drive and CSRC is the building immediately on your right. Parking is available in the back and side of the building.

**From US-23 (Heading north)** Take M-14 West towards Ann Arbor.

Take Miller Rd. exit. At the end of the exit ramp go past the stop street (Maple Rd.) and you will come to Miller Rd. Turn right onto Miller Rd. and head West to Zeeb Rd. (second stop sign). Turn right onto Zeeb Rd. and the first stop is Huron River Dr. Turn left onto Huron River Dr. and approximately 1.5 miles down make a right turn onto the cross drive connecting CSRC to Joy Road. The building at the corner is the Dexter Research Center (7300 Huron River Dr.). CSRC is the large building up the drive.
